

## Washington State Wrestling Association

**CONGRATULATIONS-** you have qualified for **2011 WESTERN REGIONAL** in Pocatello, ID on June 19-25. This means that you have placed in the top 8 of your weight division in either Greco Roman or Freestyle or both.

This year you will register and pay on [www.trackwrestling.com](http://www.trackwrestling.com). Please note if you were 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> for each style. (I will be monitoring each weight class for this information). The flyer on [www.themat.com](http://www.themat.com) reads \$30 for one style, \$50 for two styles, and \$60 for all three styles. Wrestlers who register on trackwrestling must **BRING** the completed **OFFICIAL/MEDICAL WAIVER & REGISTRATION FORMS** to me when you pick up your weigh-in cards at Western Regional if you do not fill the forms out when you register. You can find the forms on at [www.themat.com](http://www.themat.com).

If you are petitioning to get in, please register as normal on [www.trackwrestling.com](http://www.trackwrestling.com) with the style and weight you want to participate in. Write me a letter requesting the petition that matches your request. If you wrestled the state tournament of the style you are petitioning and did not qualify in the top 8, then you must add an additional \$ 5.00 fee per style that you did not qualify in. If you missed the state tournament completely and want to petition in, then you must add the petition fee and an additional \$25.00 fee per style that you missed. For the payment, you will want to send a cashier's check or money order **ONLY (no personal checks or cash)**. Send to me by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Have the cashier's check or money order made out to WSWA or Washington State Wrestling Association (not USA Wrestling).

All Intermediate, Novice, and Schoolboy/girl wrestlers participating in the Freestyle and Greco-Roman Western Regional tournament qualify for the ASICS Kids Freestyle & Greco-Roman National Championships in Farmington, Utah; June 27-29, 2011. Therefore, the Washington State Folkstyle Tournament has no bearing for weight qualification (you can only use your state freestyle and Greco for weight qualifications).

Your wrestler may move up one weight class, provided a weight spot is open. (Most of the time Washington does not bring all 8 qualifying wrestlers).

Example: Little Billy qualifies at State Greco at 65 lbs but by the time June comes around he is weighing 70 lbs. He can wrestle up at 70 lbs. **YOU CANNOT MOVE DOWN A WEIGHT CLASS**. However, if your child qualifies in Greco at 65 lbs and then in freestyle at 70 lbs, he/she can wrestle at either weight at Western Regional but must be the same weight for both styles.

The Bantam Freestyle and Folkstyle Festival Tournament is not a qualifier for any event. However, this festival tournament is open to all Bantams, regardless of their state of residence.

### CADET REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Competition is open to all Cadets, regardless of state of residence. This event **IS NOW** a qualifier for the **2011 ASIC Cadet National Championships** for Freestyle and Greco. This would be similar to Northwest Cadet Regional in Battleground, WA.
