

Congratulations! Placing in the top 6 in the Washington State Tournament is in it's self something to be proud of! In doing so, you have earned the right to enter the Western Regional Championships to be held in Butte, Montana, June 16-21. Please read the following very carefully.

* This tournament is a pre entry tournament, and there are deadlines to be met!

* We will hold your spot until May 21, 2003. If we do not hear from you by that date, we will assume you cannot attend Western Regionals.

***If you want to enter, you must do the following by May 21, 2003.**

1. Fill out the official entry COMPLETELY!
2. You must send proof of age.
3. Make sure the parent and the wrestler both sign both sides of the entry.
4. Entry deadline: May 21, 2003.
5. Entry Fee is \$20 per style (freestyle and Greco).

*** MONEY ORDER or CASHIERS CHECK ONLY! (CASH OR CHECKS WILL BE SENT BACK!!!)**

*Because of the time factors, you need to sit right down with your parents, and complete the above steps, and get your entry into tomorrow's mail.

Western Regional Freestyle and Greco-Roman Championships Kids and Cadet Divisions

All Coaches and parents of Kids and cadets who placed in the top 6 at state, and therefore, qualified to wrestle in Butte from July 16-21, need to be aware that these wrestlers must enter by May 21st!

We need to meet the Butte deadline. Late entrants may not get in. When there are viable petitions for entry to the competition, we will fill the empty spaces with the first wrestlers who qualify. When we have reached our limit, we are allowed no more entries.

Do follow the instructions below:

*Both Kids and Cadets will wrestle at the qualifying weight or a higher one. A wrestler may move up a weight at Butte, but nobody can move down in weight. It is possible to qualify at different weights for the different styles.

*Coaches are also advised to pick up a couple of entry forms for those wrestlers who may change their minds at the last minute.

*Officials request that a coaches card and a minimum of a Copper Certification is required for a floor pass. The coaches card is available from your club.

*A Copper Certification Clinic will be held in Butte on June 17, 18, and 20th. The times are listed on the entry form.

*Reserve Motel and R.V. Spaces now! There are numbers on the entry form.

*Keep in mind that on your trip, that Butte is on Mountain Daylight time, and is one your ahead of us!
