Policies and Procedures for National Dual Meet Championships [Schoolboy/Schoolgirl]

FILA Rules and USA Wrestling modifications apply in all circumstances not covered in these procedures.

I. Mission Statement

Provide a low cost opportunity for individuals to get the widest possible exposure to national caliber competition prior to the individual Kids, Cadet and Junior National Championships. Provide an opportunity for maximum competition opportunities. Provide a method to determine the National Championship Team in the age groups above.

II. Team Selection

The appropriate USAW State Chairperson must certify all teams from his/her state association.

III. Preliminary Registration and Deposit

Each state may pre-register more than one team per style, however, each state will be given preference to having at least one team in the tournament before a second team from another state will be admitted with exception noted below. Once the above criteria has been met, second teams will be added to the tournament based on the receipt of their preliminary registration, their \$500 fee and tenure competing in the event. The host team will have the option of entering a second team in each style, regardless.

IV. Team Registration Fee

Each state must pay a \$500 entry fee for each team entered. The registration fee is due no later than May 1st. Registration fees must be sent to the Indiana State Wrestling Association.

V. Individual Eligibility

Age and eligibility requirements for the individual Junior, Cadet, and Schoolboy/Schoolgirl Division National Championships shall be applied.

VI. Officials

- A. The USAW National Dual Team Championships are sanctioned as a USA Wrestling National Event. USWOA certified officials will receive national credit for participating in these

championships. The LOC will supply 20 rooms or 40 beds for USWOA designated officials and staff.

- B. Each state is responsible to supply at least one official for each style in which the state is competing.

VII. Home Team Determination for Each Dual

A coin flip between the coaches at the beginning of each dual meet will determine who must send their wrestler to the mat first. Both wrestlers must report in to the Mat Chairperson prior to the match. [See NHSF Wrestling Rule Book rule 6-2-2.]

VIII. Team and Athlete Limitations

Team entries shall be limited to 28 Greco-Roman teams and 36 freestyle teams. Each team will be comprised of the following number of athletes: Schoolboy maximum 27, minimum 9

IX. Team Seeding Criteria

- A. All teams shall be assigned a draw number at registration.
- B. Schoolboy/girls have no individual rankings. The top eight state teams from the previous year's National Schoolboy/Schoolgirl Dual Meet Championship will be seeded according to their placement. If a state from the previous year is not entered, all placing states from the previous year will move up. The top sixteen teams, if possible will be seeded into pools using the seeding criteria. Coaches must provide information on athletes at the time of registration. Falsification of seeding criteria will result in forfeiture of team placement.
- C. Only the top 18 athletes for Schoolboy/girl will be counted in the criteria. No more than two wrestlers in a weight may score points.

X. Competition Format

- A. Teams will be placed in pools based on seeding determined by the above seeding criteria, which will be tabulated by the host Association. The teams with the most points will be seeded highest.

Pool Seeds: Pool A 1, 8, 9, 16
 Pool B 2, 7, 10, 15
 Pool C 3, 6, 11, 14
 Pool D 4, 5, 12, 13

- B. Seeded teams shall be placed into the appropriate pools [see above]. If teams are tied in seeding points, the lowest draw number will be seeded highest. Teams from the same state will be placed in the next pool on the opposite side of the bracket from their highest seeded same state team. If there are more than two teams from the same state, the lowest draw number will be separated first. Separate states with multi-teams next. If "A" pool is smallest of the pools after the seeded teams

and states are separated, place the lowest draw number in “A”, the next team in the next available pool and even out the pools. Re-order remaining State teams by draw number and place first [lowest] in the smallest pool to equalize the pools. Filling pools will continue in order until all are placed in the pools.

- C. Seeded teams from the same state will remain in their designated pool [A, B, C, D]. The team leader has the option of withdrawing the lowest seeded team who will no longer be seeded and placed in the next available pool, opposite of the seeded team, to prevent the state team from meeting in the preliminary rounds. If a team pulls their lowest seeded team, all other teams will move up and the next highest team will be seeded.
- D. Competition will continue after completing the matches in pools A-D by repooling the top two pool finishers into Red and Blue pools. The second pooling of the championship bracket will place teams in a Red and Blue championship pools as follows: Red-A 1st, B 2nd, C 2nd, D 1st. Blue – A 2nd, B 1st, C 1st, D 2nd. If two teams from the same state advance to the same pool finals they will be scheduled to wrestle the first dual of the pool. Teams will wrestle every team in their pool and be placed in order of finish by won/loss record.
1. Teams in a three way tie: The highest total classification points earned between the tied teams in the tie will determine the winner.
 2. If two teams are tied or have the same classification points, head to head results will determine their placement.
 3. If the three teams are tied in classification points, the classification points earned during the entire pool competition rounds will be used to break the tie.
- E. The third place teams through the sixth place teams will be placed in a straight-line single elimination bracket and will compete for the consolation championship. The third place teams will be seeded based on number of positive marks. All other teams will be placed in the bracket according to the bracketing procedures outlined in the National High School Federation Rulebook, Rule 10, Section 3.
- F. If two teams are tied in an individual dual the following criteria will be used.
- The most victories
 - The most victories by fall
 - The most victories by technical superiority (10+)
 - The most 4.0 victories not including technical superiority or falls
 - The most victories by decision
 - The fewest defeats
 - The lowest draw number

XI. Team Placing

The Championship shall be determined by wrestling the winner of the Red Pool vs the winner of the Blue Pool. Third place will be the second place finisher in the Blue Pool vs the second place finisher in

the Red Pool. Fifth Place will be the third place finisher in the Blue Pool vs the third place finisher in the Red Pool. Seventh Place will be the fourth place finisher in the Blue Pool vs the fourth place finisher in the Red Pool. The consolation bracket will be a 16-team single elimination tournament with the winner determined to be the Consolation Champion.

XII. Awards

Eight national team plaques will be awarded to the first through eighth places in the Greco-Roman and Freestyle competition. Medals will be awarded to the first through eighth place teams in both styles. The total number of medals to be awarded per team are : Schoolboy/Schoolgirl 27, Cadets 26, Juniors 24] Consolation trophies and medals will be given to Consolation Champions in both styles.

XIII. Dual Tournament Misconduct

A. Individual

Rule 8 Section 1; Article 4 of the HS Federation Rulebook shall apply. Unsportsmanlike conduct by a wrestler prior to or after the conclusion of wrestling or against any other individual results in the deduction of one team point and suspension from the next dual meet for the first offense. On the second offense, the individual will be removed from the premises and an additional one team point will be deducted.

B. Coach

Rule 8 Section 1, article 5 of the HS Federation Rulebook shall apply.

Misconduct of coach results in a warning for the first offense [yellow card], the deduction of a team point for the second offense and the removal of the coach for the remainder of that *day*.

[This is a recent change in the HS Federation Rule Book.]

C. Flagrant Misconduct

Rule 8 Section 1, article 6 of the HS Federation Rulebook shall apply.

Flagrant misconduct results in the disqualification of the individual, removal from the premises, and the deduction of two team points on the first offense. Any contestant so disqualified may not compete further in the event regardless of style.

XIV. Registration shall be conducted the night before the competition whenever possible.

XV. Weigh-In

A. Juniors and Cadets will weigh-in two hours before the beginning of each style of competition. Schoolboy/girls will weigh-in the night before the beginning of each style competition and may weigh in once for both styles.

B. There shall be no weight allowance at any weigh in.

C. Individuals competing in both styles shall meet the weigh-in regulations for each style in each division.

- D. Individuals may change weight classifications for each style [FS, GR]. Schoolboy/girls must weigh in again if they do change weight classes.
- E. Wrestlers are eligible to wrestle in either the weight class they weighed at or the next higher weight class.
- F. States with multiple teams will have until the start of weigh-in to make changes in their line-ups. They must notify tournament director and head pairer of changes prior to the start of weigh-in.

XVI. Team Forfeits

- A. Teams wishing to withdraw during the tournament must notify the tournament director. The remainder of their matches will be defaulted; subsequent opponents will receive dual scores of 3-0. In the event of a three-way tie for advancing to pool rounds, classification rounds earned against the default team will not be counted for any team.
- B. A team that forfeits a dual meet will be eliminated from the Tournament. All teams must wrestle a minimum of 50% of their available wrestlers.

XVII. All Tournament Teams

An Cadet and Junior all tournament team will be selected for each style consisting of all weights. The all tournament team in each style will be selected based on the individuals total classification points for the tournament. In the event of a tie, both wrestlers will represent the weight class.

XVIII. Exhibition Matches

Exhibition matches shall be held only with the approval of the event director and the number of exhibition matches may not bring the total matches wrestled over 15 in the Juniors, 17 in the Cadets and 17 in the Schoolboy/Girl.

XIX. Protest Procedure

All protests must be done at the time of the rule infraction. Judgment calls may not be protested. Coaches must immediately notify the mat chairperson of the protest. The dual meet will stop until contact is established with the Head Match Official and a conference is held. The Head Mat Official and the participating Mat Officials involved in the meet will make the decision at mat side. Their decision is final.

All wrestlers must complete an individual entry form. A copy of the required form is enclosed in this packet. You need not send the forms but please bring them with you to weigh-ins.

Coaches Certification

All coaches must have a current USAW Coaches membership card and be a minimum NCEP Copper Certified
